

Welcome to the season of Advent

The word "advent" comes from the Latin *adventus*, which means "arrival" or "coming." The term's original meaning was the arrival of a person of noble birth. Therefore, in the season of Advent, we remember Jesus of Nazareth's three distinct and intimate arrivals: in the manger, at the end of time, and in our hearts.

The Bible says the cry, 'Come', expresses the Holy Spirit's greatest longing for Christ's return and the establishment of His kingdom. This cry emphasises spiritual renewal and personal development. The final establishment of the kingdom will be characterised by strength, glory, power, and victory.

Three lessons about Advent can be learnt from St Luke's Chapter 2 account of Jesus' birth:

- The importance of faith and obedience
- The power of God's love and mercy
- The joy of salvation and redemption

In this season of Advent, let us eagerly anticipate our Lord's second coming in His glorious, powerful, and triumphant splendour. This anticipation fills us with hope and reassurance. Come, Lord Jesus, come.
